Adopt County Wellness Option Incentives for 2023 Plan Year for Health Insurance

Commissioner ____ moved, upon request of the Assistant County Administrator, to authorize the Clark County Wellness Option for calendar year 2023 for employees, elected officials, and county officers participating in county health insurance benefits. County employees, elected officials and county officers (hereinafter referred to as employee) who complete their annual preventative visit and required wellness points between September 16, 2021 and September 15, 2022, will receive a premium credit January 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023. The points required are based upon the level of health insurance plan in which the employee participates at the time of approval of the employee's wellness incentive by Marsh & McLennan Agency (MMA).

In order to receive a wellness credit in calendar year 2023, each employee must complete the necessary requirements and points as instructed in the form titled "Clark County Ohio 2023 Wellness Incentives – Participation Requirements and Options" and submit proof as directed on the form no later than 5:00 p.m. September 23, 2022. Employee participants in the wellness program are required to verify proper credit on their paycheck within the first month after application of the discount. Retroactive discounts will not be applied after the first pay in February.

Authorize the Allocation of American Rescue Plan Act Funds for the MVECA Fiber Service Project

Commissioner moved, per request of the County Administrator to approve the following purchase:

Whereas, Clark County has received direct payments from the United States (US) Treasury under the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Funds authorized by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); and,

Whereas, Clark County will use the funding in accordance with ARPA and guidance from the US Treasury; and,

Whereas, the Department of Treasury issued the Interim Final Rule on May 10, 2021, to provide guidance on permissible uses; and,

Whereas, a permissible use of the ARPA funds is to make necessary investments in broadband infrastructure through projects that will improve the usage of broadband services and Internet capacity; and,

Whereas, the implementation of the Miami Valley Educational Computer Association (MVECA) Fiber Services into infrastructure that will include dark fiber technology, will allow the County to have greater control over costs associated with connectivity to the Internet and to local network resources.

Now therefore, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, that:

The Board of County Commissioners approves the use of the ARPA funds toward the MVECA Fiber Service Project in the amount of \$2,181,091.73.
