

The Board of Clark County Commissioners met in regular session pursuant to adjournment in accordance with Section 121.22 O.R.C. (Sunshine Law) at the Commission Office, 50 East Columbia Street, Springfield, Ohio.

The following members and guests were present: Commissioner Melanie Flax Wilt; Commissioner Lowell McGlothin; Commissioner Richard L. Lohnes; Michelle Noble, Assistant County Administrator/HR Director; Emily Carter, Acting Commission Clerk; Michael Cooper, Public Information Officer; Beau Thompson, Assistant County Prosecutor; Chuck Bauer, Utilities Director, Melissa Tuttle, Clerk of Courts; Ginny Martycz, JFS Director; Riley Newton, Springfield News Sun; Allan Neimayer, Community and Economic Development; Shane Nugent; Rhonda Nugent; Dan Phillips; Larry Pegram.

Commissioner Wilt called the meeting to order and introductions were made.

Melissa Tuttle said there were 245 passports accepted for the year 2020 so far. They had 930 for the year 2019, so passports had increased, and they were real ID compliant. She explained that when they started their Saturday hours, they were open from 9am to 1pm. They had people lined up when they opened so they changed their hours to 8:30am to 12:30pm. Commissioner Wilt suggested promoting the passports through a news release when the health scare passes. Commissioner McGlothin asked if the office in New Carlisle does passports. Ms. Tuttle said yes by appointment only due to being a smaller facility.

Agenda Review:

Commissioner McGlothin asked about the following:

Resolution 2020-0185 was approving payment to Kapp Construction. He said he was glad they were getting paid and continuing the project.

Commissioner Lohnes asked about the following:

Resolution 2020-0182 was resolving a title discrepancy for county owned land. He asked where the 1.45 acres was located at. Ms. Noble said it was between the fairgrounds and the armory.

Commissioner Wilt had no questions. She said there had been lots of discussion on coronavirus and public health. County directors had met the day prior to discuss plans. Ms. Noble said they had asked the directors to look at their operations plan and update them by the end of the week. They were to look at what was considered essential services and get prepared if people were to be quarantined. Commissioner Lohnes said he wanted to see the plans. He said they needed to identify the priority departments that still need to function. He said the Department of Job and Family Services deal mostly with the people. Ms. Martycz said it was probably not a good time to shut down when people are most vulnerable.

Commissioner Lohnes said there had been some questions and concerns from staff. One being about sending staff home when they are sick. Ms. Noble said they were encouraging that. She said there was one concern about using sick leave if someone was quarantined. She said they were able to use sick leave, but the concern was for the newer people who did not have sick leave to use. Commissioner Lohnes said they had the information and needed to send guidance out to the directors and the elected officials. Commissioner Wilt said the communication to the public was good. She said people were going to be interested to know what the county was doing, and our message needed to be business as usual with health precautions. Discussion ensued.

County Administrator Updates:

Ms. Noble said there was an add on for the rebid of the 911 Communication Center. The first bids came in over the 10% of the estimate and were all rejected. They wanted to keep that project moving.

Strategic Plan Updates:

Commissioner Wilt asked if the AB Graham and Springview project was coming along and Ms. Noble said yes.

The board reviewed the calendar and gave event updates.

Comprehensive plan has it zoned as agricultural and residential use. Staff recommends approval as presented.

Commissioner Lohnes asked if it was a cleanup of what was already done. Mr. Neimayer said yes. Commissioner Lohnes asked if the applicant would have to go back and get all the permits and inspections that were needed and not done initially. Mr. Neimayer said yes.

Audience Comments: Dan Philips said in the beginning, they were looking to build a new garage. There was family that lived with them at the time, and they needed their own space. They heard about the mother in-law suite, and so they decided to turn the structure into another house. They did the process backwards and wanted to make it right for insurance, taxes and future building.

Commissioner Wilt said it has become common of doing things first and asking for forgiveness later. She wanted to make the public aware that the process was done backwards and that the process needs to be done the right way.
