**POLICY**

Some permit movements may require special work by the County for the protection of the public or state highway facilities. Such work may include, but is not limited to, engineering analysis, route detours, special traffic control, or temporary bridge shoring to accommodate a specific load.

Prior to the issuance of a permit when such work is required, the applicant will be responsible for the reimbursement of the total direct costs incurred by the County in the performance of such special work. The County Engineer will estimate the total direct costs to be incurred by the County and the applicant shall deposit this amount with the County in the form of cash, check, or money order prior to the performance of such work and issuance of a permit by the County. If the special work is not performed, then entire deposit will be returned to the applicant. If the work is performed and the total direct cost is less than the amount on deposit, then any excess will be returned to the applicant. If the work is performed and the total direct cost is greater than the amount on deposit, then the applicant will be billed for the deficiency. This fee for special work is in addition to the application processing fees.

Special Hauling Permits must be accompanied by the designated fees. Applications not in compliance with this policy will not be considered for a permit. All permits applied for at the County Engineer's Office must be paid by cash, check or money order.

Fee requirements are waived for federal, state and local governments, and any political subdivisions thereof.
