Selma Pike and E. Possum Road Intersection Improvements

As you are aware, the Clark County Engineer's Office has proposed a roundabout at the intersection of Selma Pike and E. Possum Road at the new Clark-Shawnee school campus. We appreciate the community feedback and the many comments submitted for the project. Enclosed is a summary of the questions and concerns submitted and the County Engineer's response to each comment.


After review and consideration of the public input, this office has determined that the preferred alternative (a single-lane roundabout) is still the best solution and the appropriate treatment to address the expected traffic congestion. Many comments supported the traffic signal and all-way stop alternatives, but the project feasibility study already examined and ruled out these alternatives. There were no other viable alternatives proposed in the public comments, and there were no concerns identified for the roundabout in relation to historical, social or environmental impacts.

The County Engineer will discuss the public comments with the design consultant and incorporate them in the plans as appropriate. The project is on schedule to bid in late 2022 with the majority of construction occurring in the spring and summer of 2023.
