







## How Does It Work?

You bring your unwanted furniture item. The item is measured using a 4' x 4' template. If the item is smaller than the template, it costs \$5 to dispose of. If the item is larger than the template, it costs \$10 to dispose of.



Residential-commercial recycling rate/tons recycled (2021 ADR data)





