Meeting Minutes

I. Meeting was called to order at 8:36 AM. 14 members present.

- a) Welcome and introductions.

II. Approval of Minutes

- a) Chair shared 2 reminders:
 - i) The steering committee will not vote on meeting minutes during full committee meetings. Minutes will be voted on at the next steering committee meeting.
 - ii) Approved minutes are shared on the Reentry Department Website.
- b) A motion was made to approve the minutes for January, then seconded. Unanimous approval for January meeting minutes.
- c) A motion was made to approve the minutes for February, then seconded. Unanimous approval for February meeting minutes.

III. Old Business

- a) We welcomed our new Vice Chair, Gina Kicos from the VA office. Vote was held electronically in January, unanimous approval by voting members.
- b) TTT Grant
 - i) Coalition members can sign up to be part of the 4 hour training on April 6th, 8:30-12:30 PM. The following steering committee members requested to be added: Kelton Moore, Robert Beckel, Erin Willoughby, Gina Kicos, and Erin Deas. There are still 5 spaces available for the short Trauma Informed Care Training. Those attending the morning training are asked to keep their cameras off during the training.
 - ii) Reminder for TTT Training sites to complete the registration link ASAP so course materials can be shared. The TTT is scheduled for April 6th and 7th. It is virtual and cameras will need to remain on.
- c) SIS – Chair discussed reasons for delaying sharing the SIS which was planned to be shared in March. The Reentry Dept is coordinating with community partners about FCW and will begin SIS coordination after FCW (April 26th).
- d) Homeless Court
 - i) Vice Chair provided an overview of homeless court for new members and updated the committee about the progress of the homeless court. We are waiting to hear



from the Court before scheduling a virtual meeting with the ABA. We briefly discussed who needs to be on the committee. Committee members discussed the ethical considerations regarding membership. We determined more information about committee membership best practices will be needed if Homeless Court moves forward in Clark County.

e) Legal Clinic Update

- i) The legal clinic on February 25 was successful. We had 20 residents attend and 11 were able to submit record sealing paperwork with the court.
- ii) The next legal clinic is scheduled for June 10th, 11-2 PM at the Clark County Public Library. A flyer for the event was distributed.

f) Reentry Month

- i) The following events to build community capacity about reentry and the needs of justice impacted citizens are planned for the month of April.
 - (1) Trauma Informed Care Training: April 6 8:30-12:30 PM online for Reentry Coalition Members. TTT TIC April 6th and 7th registered applicants.
 - (2) Justice Involved Speaker: April 13 12-1 PM, CC Public Library. Albert Hudgins Veteran and reentry advocate. Why Reentry Matters: One man's journey from incarceration to peace of mind.
 - (3) Wallet Drive being held all month. Organizations interested in collecting wallets should contact the chair.
 - (4) Fair Chance Wednesday: April 26 1-3 PM, 1101 E High St, Springfield, OH. A link has been shared with all steering and full committee members to register for the event.
